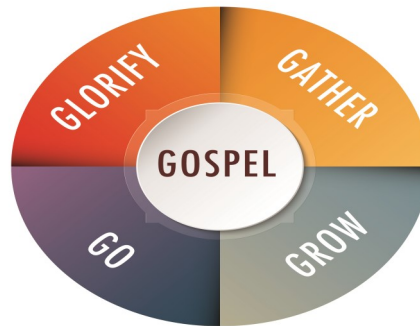

Expectations

Club Attendance

Clubber should attend faithfully throughout the year.

We encourage you to arrive early.

Please arrive between **6:00 - 6:10pm** for sign-in; to be ready for Awana club to start at 6:15pm.

Dress & Shoes

Once a clubber has earned a uniform, it should be kept clean and worn each week. Part of earning awards for them is to get Awana Bucks for the store by wearing their uniforms and having sturdy shoes each week. As well as bringing their class materials and a bible each week. Closed toed athletic type shoes are essential for clubbers protection when playing the Awana games.

Participation

Every clubber is expected to participate in all aspects of the program. Each Club has a goal to complete 1 book, your child can accomplish by attending each week.

Facilities

All clubbers are expected to stay within the areas designated by their leaders. We ask that the children stay away from areas that are not well lit; this includes the playground after dark. Once a clubber has been dismissed to a responsible adult we are no longer responsible for their safety.

Costs

\$90.00 per student for the year; (\$2.81 a week) you can pay all up front or make payments. Partial Scholarships are available.
