WORK EXPERIENCE – Gear up to work hard at camp! Doing outdoor work, cleaning dishes (750 place settings daily!), toilets, sinks, and floors takes up a huge part of every day. In addition, you will enjoy tubing, beach volleyball, rock climbing, laughter, spontaneous fun, and lots more. A certificate of completion will be issued at the end of Work Crew, and can be a significant asset in applying for a job.

Toward the end of your work crew session we will celebrate with a themed banquet. More details to follow closer to the time!

SKILL DEVELOPMENT – To prepare you as a future leader, we provide you with specific training on how to teach campers skills such as crafts, canoeing, games and other activities. We ensure our Work Crew receive relevant and positive experience with campers, working alongside our Summer Team, before they return as future Summer Team members.

SPIRITUAL GROWTH – You will go beyond your limits as we strive to provide opportunities for God to work in and through you. You will be challenged and stretched as you build relationships through activities, Bible studies, and discussion times.

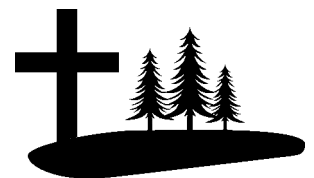
