**Cash/Checks +** Gifts must be physically received at the church by December 31, or postmarked by that date, to be reported as 2025 contributions on your giving statement. Gifts dropped off or postmarked after December 31 must be reported as 2026 contributions.

**Gifts Online +** For gifts made online through our website, [stjohncf.org/give](http://stjohncf.org/give), you should allow at least a 2-day processing time if it is important for your gift to be reported as a contribution in 2025.

**Gifts of Securities (Stocks, Bonds, Mutual Funds) +** There are tax advantages available for a charitable donation of securities that can be beneficial for some as they plan their taxes at year-end. **Charitable IRA Rollover +** If you are 70 1/2 or older, please consider an IRA charitable rollover gift if you not yet taken your required minimum distribution. Since situations vary, we encourage you to consult your tax or financial advisor regarding retirement account gifts. Please notify the church office your intent to give in this way.
