#### 2026 H2 Jamaica Mission Trip Cancelled

A few months ago, announcement was made about the H2 Jamaica mission trip scheduled for February and several St John members expressed interest in going. A few weeks ago, Hurricane Melissa devastated the western 1/3 of the island. In consultation with ministry partners in Jamaica, it was decided to cancel the medical and irrigation teams for 2026. The Jamaican Ministry of Health advised that due to extensive damage at hospitals and clinics, they could not accommodate the medical team. Many agricultural areas received over 30" of rain making irrigation work nearly impossible. Much of the area remains without power and many roads are impassable.

Fund-raising efforts are underway to help our brothers and sisters in Jamaica. Last week H2Jamaica was able to send \$10,000 to their ministry partners to help with immediate needs for food, water, shelter, and supplies. One of the H2 Jamaica Board members is traveling to Jamaica soon taking needed supplies and making an assessment of how we can provide further help.
