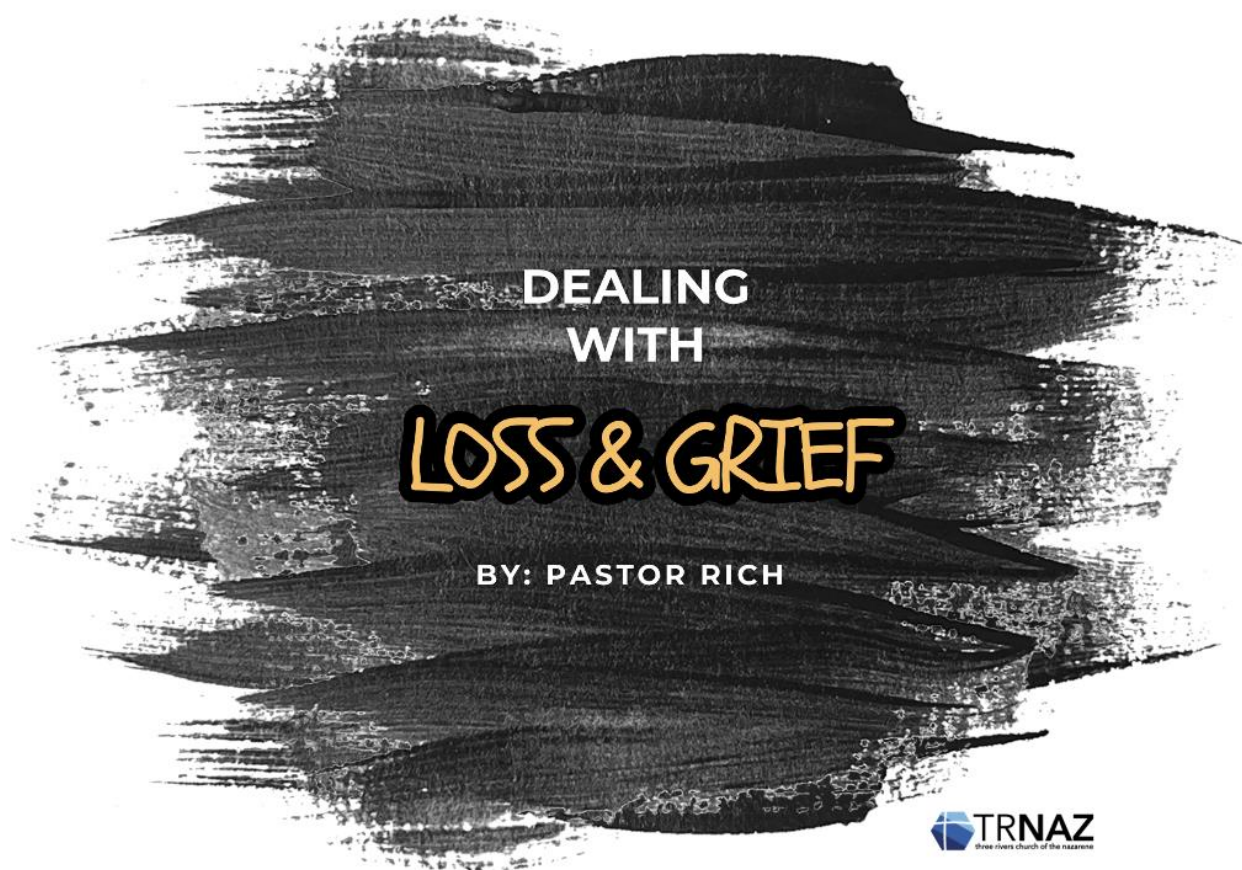




Welcome To The Reunion!
