“Come and See the Light in the Darkness”

Scripture: Matthew 5:14-16

¹⁴ “You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Summary: We live in a world that often feels dark—dark with anxiety, division, loneliness, and uncertainty. People are searching for hope, and something real. And Jesus steps into that reality and says something shocking:

“You are the light of the world.”

Not just *He is the light*—but we carry His light. This is not just identity. It’s invitation and responsibility.

Discussion Questions:

1. Where do you find it hardest to “shine your light” in your daily life?
2. What fears or obstacles tend to make you hide your faith?
3. Who is one person in your life that you can intentionally shine God’s light to this week, and how will you do it?
