

House Church Gathering Discussion Questions

Sunday November 2
"The Witness of World and Word"

Scripture: Psalm 19:1-4

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

- 2 Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge.
- 3 They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them.
- 4 Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens God has pitched a tent for the sun.

Summary: In a world where there are a lot of competing voices that fight for our attention, it's easy for us to let our lives become noisy. When they do, it can be overwhelming and hard to find *God's* voice amid all of that. But Psalm 19 tells us that God's voice can be heard through His world *and* His Word; that both reveal the glory of God, and He speaks to us for our good—and ultimately, to lead us into the best life: a life lived in relationship with Jesus, enjoying the free gift of His salvation, staying connected to Him through both creation and Scripture, and being ready witnesses to a waiting world.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How often do you see God's glory in the world that He's made? When you don't, what do you think distracts you from it most often?
- 2. Have you been loving your time in God's Word lately? Why or why not? (If yes, how can you stay in that good place? If no, what do think would help you stay consistent?)
- 3. Which one of the applications (enjoy God's creation, spend time in His Word, speak the gospel to our unbelieving friends) challenge you the most? Are there any that you feel particularly convinced of beginning pursuing anew?
