Cheryl continues to oversee the work in Tanzania full time, working on long term sustainability of the organization and ensuring that the work continues well. She now spends 1/3 of her time abroad and works remotely on administrative items and fundraising when she is in the States. Caleb is about to start his second year at Harding University, majoring in molecular biology and biochemistry. Levi, Isaac, and Asher are attending CrossPointe Preparatory Academy in Searcy.

- Michael Carruth, Lon's son and Erin's brother, passed away Wednesday from a long bout with Cancer. Let's all be praying for this loved family!

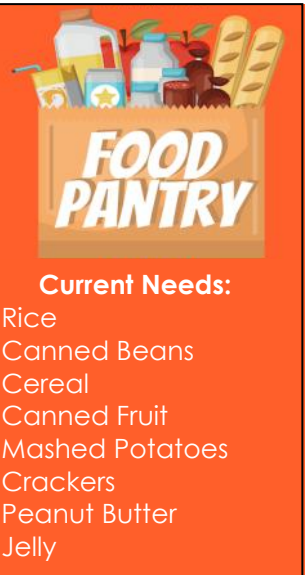

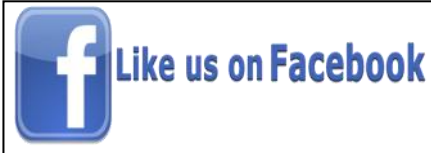
