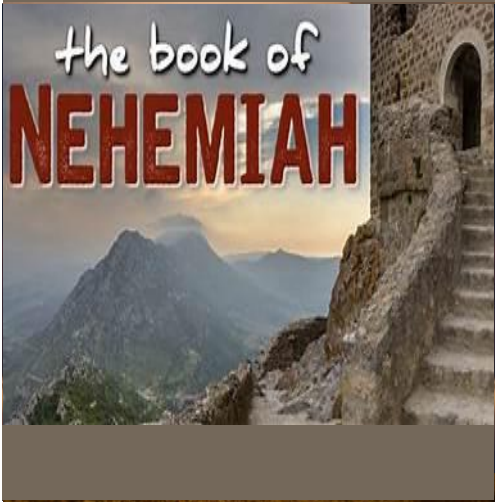

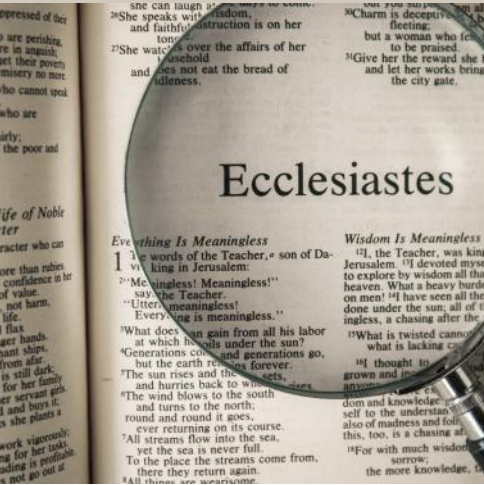

This summer Cheryl and Scott McFaddin provided an update on the mission work in Tanzania, and they told us about a poultry project. The primary goal is to produce and sell eggs and chicken manure to generate sustainable income for the operations of Neema House Tanzania and improve local food security. Eggs and chicken manure are easy to sell in the local markets. The plan is to start with 1,000 egg-laying hens. The estimated startup cost is \$31,325 and \$10,000 has already been secured.

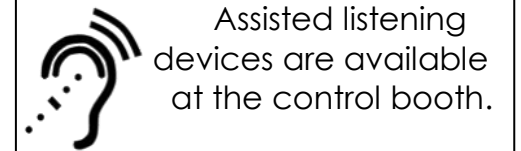
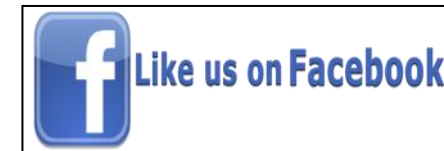
