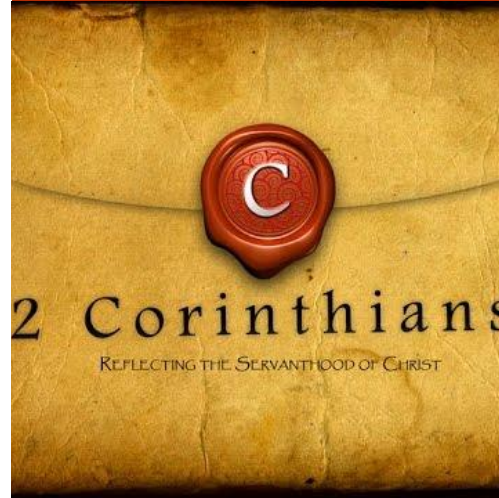

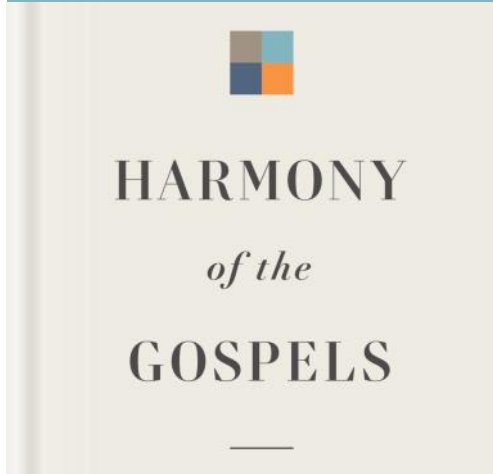
One of the privileges of following Jesus is the opportunity to regularly give of our material blessings so it can be used to help the church family complete the work it's been called to do.

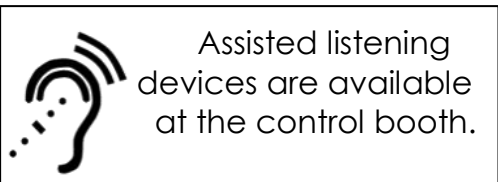

This is an update from Trey Durrance who is on our prayer list :
 "I haven't provided many updates lately, mostly because we haven't known exactly what was going on. On one hand, the leukemia is under control. And on the other, I haven't been able to breathe for a year and a half due to increasingly large volumes of fluid causing my lungs to collapse. We've had them drained, only to have the fluid rapidly reaccumulate. And no answers as to why its happening. With the most recent attempt to drain the left side, it was determined that the fluid had thickened to the point of being unable to drain and we were referred to a thoracic surgeon. He let us know that my lung function was down to 38% and that my left lung was being crushed by scarring that had been thickening over many months. Our only chance at relief is decortication with an open thoracotomy. They are going to have to cut me open from my back to my chest, separate my ribs by breaking or even removing one, evacuate the solidified pleural fluid, and scrape the scarring off of the surface of my lung. And still no answers. I never really planned on having a thoracotomy at 40. But I do know who has the answers. And I know that God has a plan for my life. Our Messiah once said "This sickness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Nobody knows what tomorrow will bring, but I know that I will wake up every day thanking God for his unending grace. Its tough sometimes, I'm only human. But Joni lifts me up daily, prays for me constantly, and is a perfect example of one of the many blessings that I've been counting. When things don't go as we plan, hope for, or pray for, we can rest in the assurance of knowing God's promises never fail."
