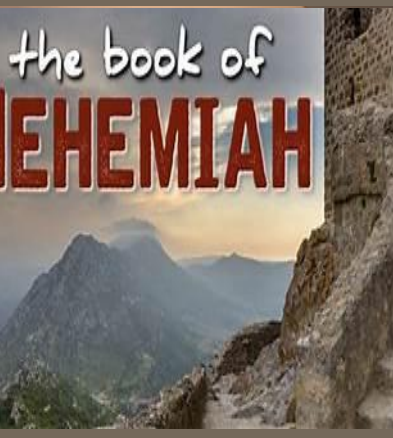


Sunday Morning Sermon

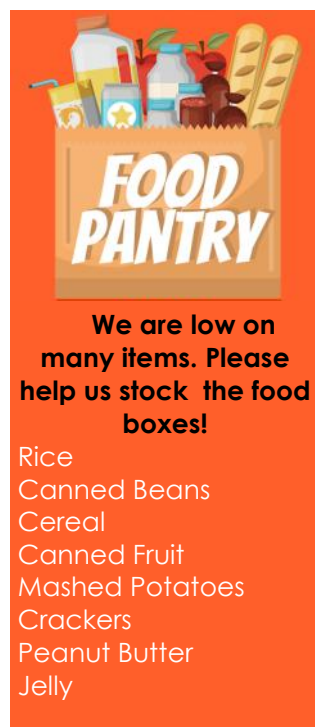
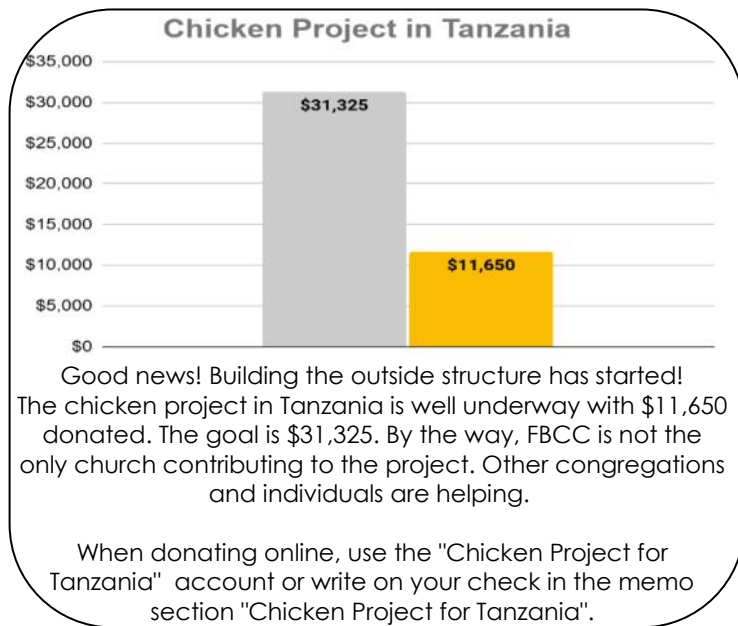

The words of the Teacher, a son of Da-
vid, king in Jerusalem:
1 "Meaningless! Meaningless!"
2 "Utter Teacher!
3 "Utter! meaningless!
4 "Everything is meaningless."
5 "What can gain from all his labor
at which he toils under the sun?"
6 "Generations come, and generations go,
but the earth remains forever."
7 The sun rises and the west goes down,
and hurries back to its place,
8 and the wind blows to the south
and turns to the north;
9 and round and round it goes,
yet the sea is never full.
10 All streams flow into the sea,
yet the sea is never full;
11 To the place the streams come from,
there they return again,
12 all things are meaningless.

Details: A light lunch will be served.

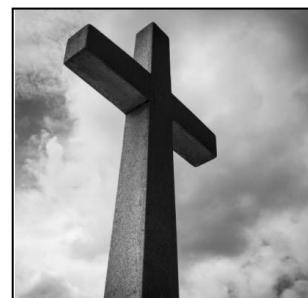

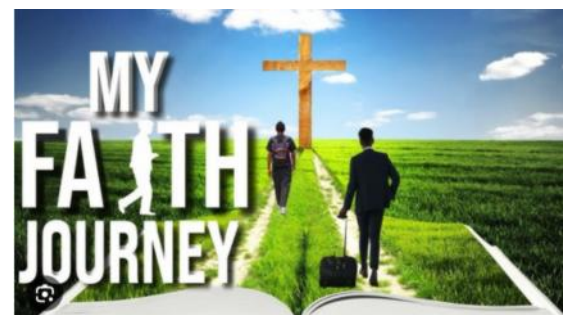
- Dub Scroggin: Jeff's brother is struggling with COPD.

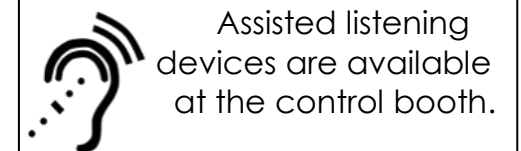
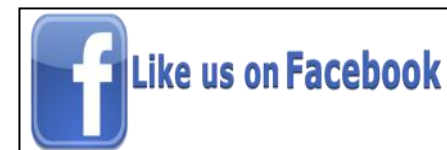
