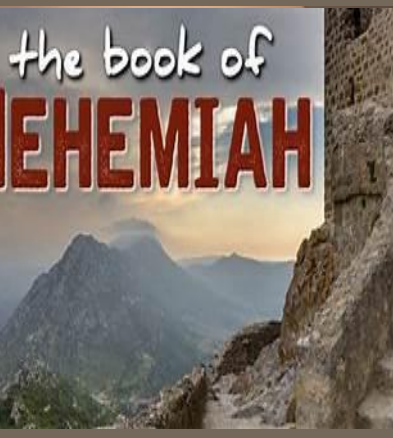


Sunday Morning Sermon

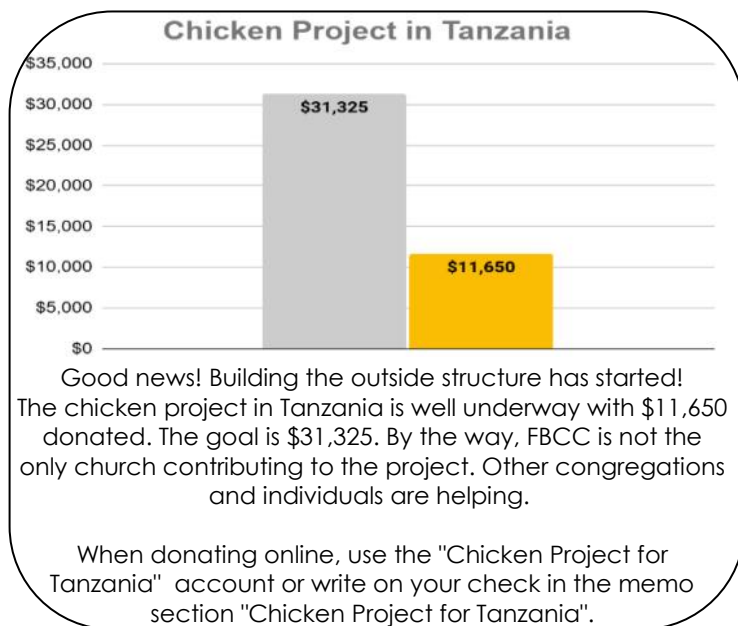

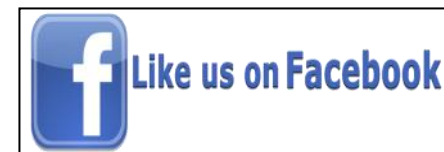
