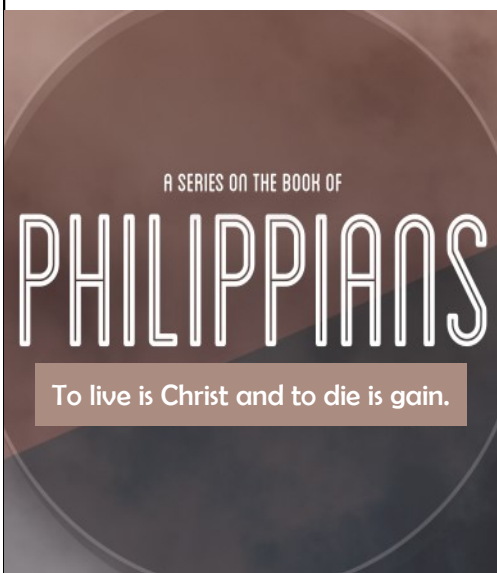

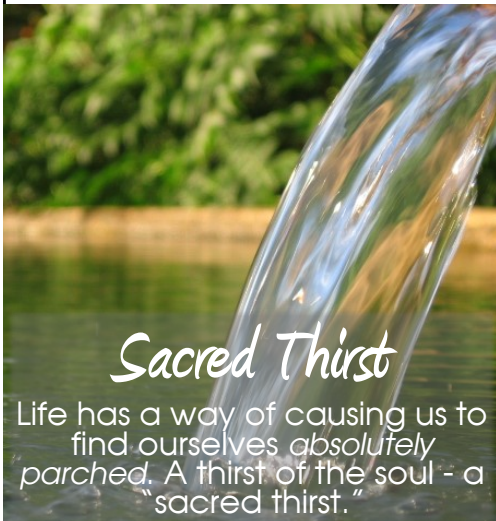

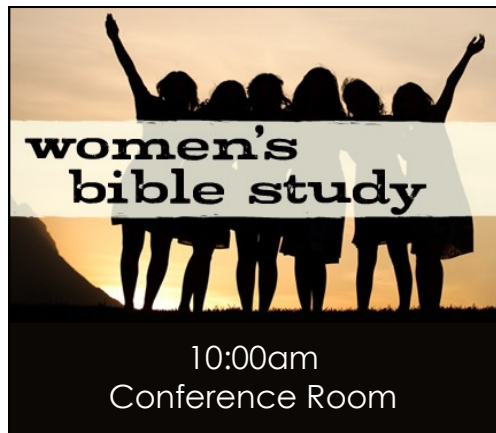

### A Cord Not Easily Broken

- Committee will be meeting with an architect this week to begin work on design requirements

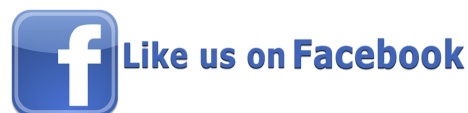
