
Saddleback Kids: The Story of Easter- The Last Supper

Materials: White paper, white (or very light colored) crayon, watercolor paints

(3) Using watercolors, paint over the entire paper. The paint won't stick to the crayon and your image will appear!

Possible or Impossible Paper Trick (Slide 1)

Can you put your head through this piece of paper without tearing it?




Materials:
Piece of paper (this piece is 6" x 5" **)
Pencil
Scissors

**A regular size sheet of paper will be large enough to step through



Step 1: Fold the piece of paper in half lengthwise





Step 2:

Use a pencil and rule to mark ½" segments starting on the folded side; alternate folded side, unfolded side (see picture at step 1 for mark help)

Step 3: Cut along the lines (make sure you don't cut all the way across- leave ¼" from the edge)



Step 4:
Cut a small amount
off the top of the
folded edge. Do not
cut the two end
pieces. When opened
up it will look like the
bottom part of the
picture.



paper!


