Praise

Psalm 95:6-7

**⁶ O come, let us worship and bow down,
let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!**

**⁷ For he is our God,
and we are the people of his pasture,
and the sheep of his hand.**

This is one of the most comforting scriptures to me. It starts with calling us to Worship the LORD. Then it leads us into understanding why God is worthy of Praise and worship. He (God) is our God and we are the people of His pasture. There is no other god in the world that shepherds His people. He knows them by name, and leads us through the “darkest valley, where we fear no evil,” (Ps 23:4) because God is with us.
