

How We Seek to Make Recovery Available to All

We are glad you are considering St. Peter's Intensive Outpatient Program. We would like to support your recovery in any way we can. The cost of this program is covered by St. Peter's Lutheran Church, client fees, and other resources listed below. We are committed to:

Keep Our Standard Fee Lower

The Standard Fee for our IOP services is lower than most programs of comparable services. After an Initial Assessment Fee of \$130, our Standard Fee is \$180 per week or \$2880 for the entire 16-week program. This includes all group therapy sessions as well as weekly individual sessions and drug screens.

Offer to Subsidize the Cost of Treatment

No one will be turned away from the St. Peter's IOP due to difficulty to pay. We are willing to offset fees that you are unable to cover. You are asked to pay all or whatever portion of the Standard Fee that you are able. Our staff will work with you in the intake process to determine an Adjusted Fee that honors your financial circumstances. Please talk with your individual counselor if, at any time, your situation changes and your Adjusted Fee needs to be revised.

Assist You in Utilizing Your Insurance

Due to the complexity and cost of billing Medicaid and private insurance, St. Peter's has chosen not to bill insurance directly. However, if you have insurance, we can work with you so that you can utilize your insurance or Health Savings Account. We can assist you in learning what your insurance covers and then provide you with a "superbill" receipt for each payment. This receipt will have all the information necessary for you to submit to your insurance company. This will enable you to apply your IOP payment toward your deductible or to be reimbursed once your deductible is met, according to your plan. You may also utilize your HSA to reimburse yourself for the payments you have made. It is important to check with your insurance company to see if they require pre-certification before you begin treatment.

Partner with Recovery Works

If you have a relationship with Community Corrections or the Probation Department, you may qualify for the Recovery Works program. Talk to your probation officer about whether you might be eligible for this funding to assist you in your recovery. A Recovery Works referral from your probation officer is necessary before you begin treatment.

We trust that God will provide the resources for St. Peter's to continue to make recovery available to anyone, regardless of one's financial circumstances. Your partnership in making this possible, to the extent that you are able, is greatly appreciated.
