OUR VISION is to reduce the electrical cost and use the savings for additional child ministries at Faith Home. With your help Faith Home can sponsor additional children, build cascas, or provide medical care for the 72 children who call Faith Home *their* home.



Honduras receives nearly 3000 useable sun hours a year.

Phase 1 of the Sunshine Project will include two photovoltaic systems with 13.72 kW of PV capacity each. One solar system on the roof of the dining hall, and the other on the roof of the workshop will provide almost all the electricity needed to run the dining hall, school buildings, workshop, and water well.

Did you know Faith Home spends over \$43,000 a year on electricity? Wouldn't it be phenomenal if that number could be reduced by 5 or even 10 thousand dollars? It can. The Sunshine Project will install 112 solar panels at Faith Home which will save \$850 *every month* in electrical costs. This project will save Faith Home \$10,200 per year.
