Using Church Assessments

Local Church Request

- Preparing for ReFocusing
- Plateau/Declining in Attendance
- Pastor asking am I in the right place
- Frustration at current reality

Pastoral Reviews

- Used as part of the regular review process
- Used in special reviews

Pastoral Transition

- Identifies current needs and expectations of the church
- Assists in the putting together a pastoral profile
- Allows the church to be intentional in interim planning

Church in Crisis

- Allows for an outside view of current reality
- Removes some of the subjectivity and makes the process more objective

The Life Cycle Tool

- Assessment tool is sent prior to the assessment weekend
- Completed by whoever desires
- Answer sheets are collected during the weekend
- Answer sheets are scored in an excel spread sheet
- Scores are transferred to PowerPoint
- Interpret the Results

Statistical Review

- Look at Worship Attendance
- Gather the Information (10 Year Trends)
- Graph the information
- Determine Comfort Zone

Treasurer Reports

- Where does the church spend the money
- Basic Percentage Breakdowns
- Conclusions

- Focus is on listening to the attitude and not just fact finding
- Results included in lay summary

Informal Conversations

- Listening for themes
- Determine the overall attitude
- Give people a chance to be heard
