1. I/We understand and agree that enrollment of my child in the Summer Clinic does NOT guarantee admission to FBCS's K-8 Program and that I must submit an additional application and meet the requirements for acceptance into the K-8 Program. My child's enrollment is dependent on my parental support of the school, its staff, and its policies.
2. I/We understand that the faculty and staff of FBCS will teach love and respect for the Lord Jesus Christ and obedience to Him.
3. FBCS's biblical role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be Christ-like. On occasion, the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home may be counter or in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, sexual immorality, homosexual orientation, or inability to support the moral principles of the school. In such cases, the school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue enrollment of a student.
4. ***I/We agree that the clinic fee must be paid prior to June 7th. We also agree that if our account is not prepaid or not in good standing, our child/children will not be admitted to the clinic. A \$25.00 service charge will be assessed for any and all returned checks and stopped payment checks. 5. It is agreed that FBCS reserves the right to expel any student if it is determined by the Administration to be in the best interest of either the student or the School. I/We also agree to pay for any damages to or loss of school property attributable to this student.
