It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet.</p> <p>¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.
