

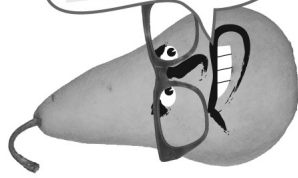
## Key Verse

## Chain Reaction

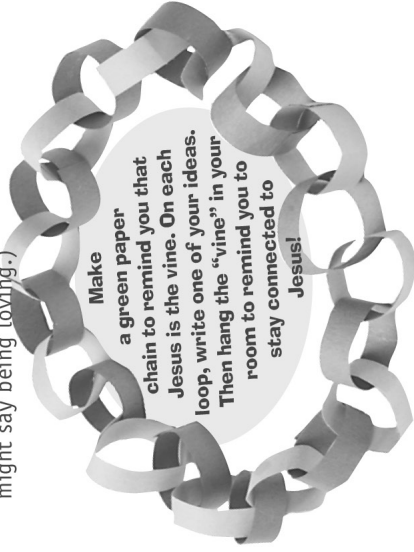
Find a friend, and read JOHN 15:5 a few times until you can say it to each other without reading it. Discuss these questions with your friend:

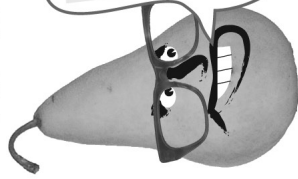
