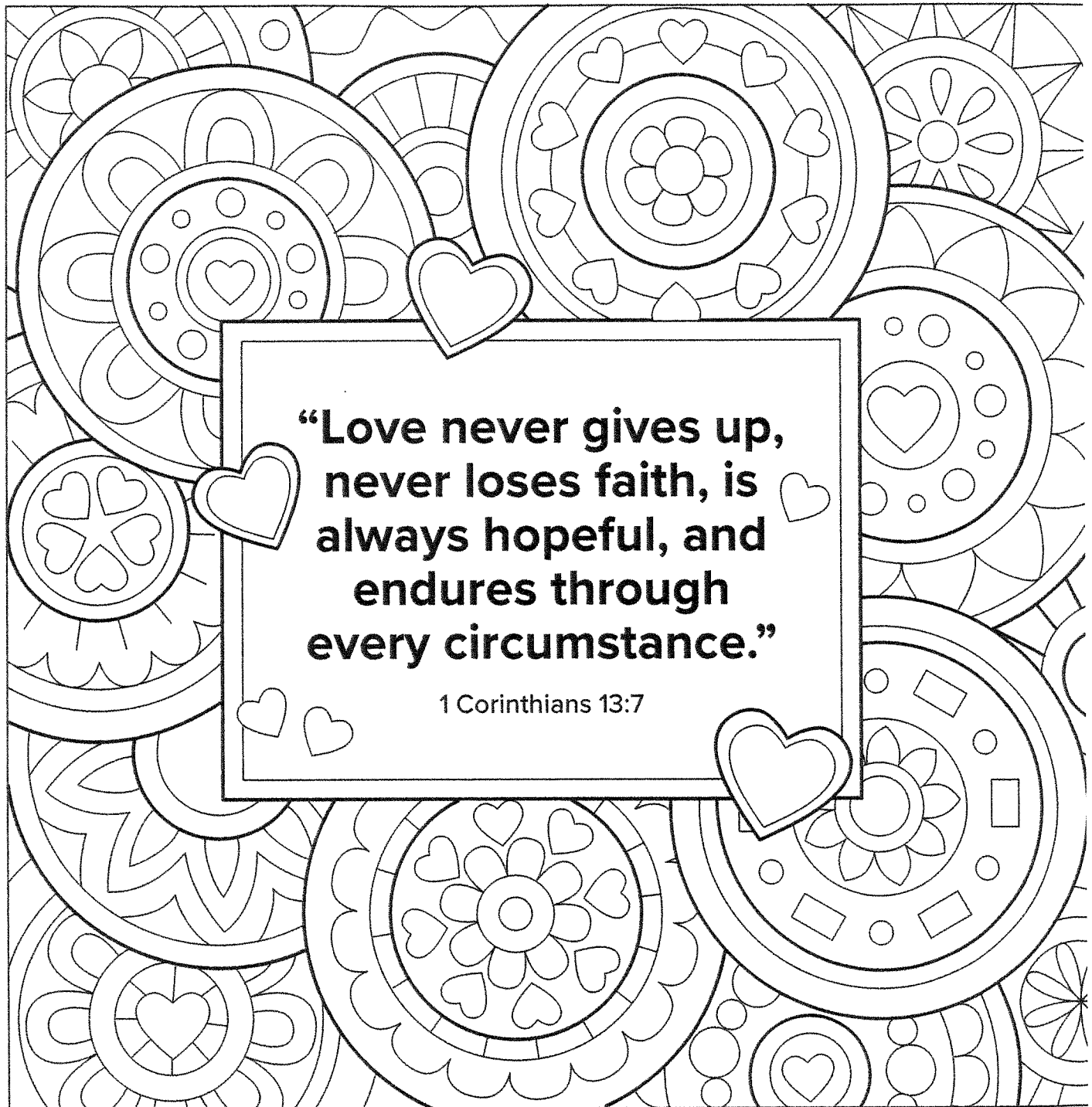


Practice patience as you use colored pencils to color all the teeny-tiny shapes on this page.

Fun Fact

A parable is a story that illustrates something true. Jesus often used parables to help people picture what God is like and what's most important to God.

God's love is unconditional. God loves you, not because of anything you've done but because of who you are—his beloved children. What if your family viewed each other like that, too?

Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 13, "Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance."
