Throughout life, Becca was more than just an Aunt, but a mother, friend, confidant and one of the most important people in my life. Now that she has passed on to eternity, I, alongside her son Jeremy (JJ) and her family have the responsibility of honoring her final wishes and laying her body to rest.

For those of you who knew Becca, you know that she was compassionate, hard-working, caring, dedicated and completely devoted to everything she set out to do. Whether it was being a mom to her two children, Christina & Jeremy, or being an advocate in the communities God placed her in, Becca joyfully and tirelessly gave of herself. She was a light everywhere she went. Becca knew no strangers, only friends she had yet to meet and her love and empathy for others was a gift to behold.

Even after the diagnosis of stage-four cancer in the winter of 2016, Becca never quit. She was committed to the people & places she loved, including her long-time church, Emerald City Bible Fellowship, and her work at Penny's Place, a therapeutic transitional home for women and families fleeing domestic violence.

We are completely heartbroken that Becca is no longer with us physically, however we know that she is whole and healed now in the Presence of God. As we know, death is always harder on the living and those who are left behind to continue on without their loved ones.

Many have reached out to ask how they can help honor Becca's life and care for her family at this difficult time. It is not easy to ask for help, but we also know that Becca's family extended so far beyond her blood, and know that many of you desire to love and bless Becca one last time.

Becca did her best to prepare for death in the hopes of avoiding undue stress on her family, but unfortunately, she did not live long enough to activate the life insurance policies that she had invested in. This has left us with a large cost to cover in laying Becca to rest.

Our family is doing our best to meet the quote that we have been given from Bonney Watson Memorial Home, which is due in full on **January 9th**. However, with such a short time-frame, another death in the family (Becca's Aunt) and other factors, the reality is that our financial need is great.

And so, it is with heavy, and also thankful, hearts that **we humbly ask those from her close communities to consider giving financially to help lay her to rest.** All donations made will go directly to Bonney Watson, towards the costs associated with preparing Becca's remains, etc. We are also more than willing to provide documentation to ensure that everything collected is going directly towards this need.
