



LEADERSHIP COUNCIL NOMINEE QUALIFICATIONS

ECBF is seeking new Leadership Council members. If you would like to nominate a member our church, please see the qualification description below and contact Pastor Harvey.

Qualifications: A potential member of the Leadership Council must be a member in good standing; uphold the principles of I Timothy 3:1-7 (qualifications of leaders) and Galatians 5:22 (fruit of the Spirit); be at least 25 years of age; live within 25 miles of the church; must demonstrate leadership and shepherding skills; be a committed financial supporter of the church; accept and adhere to the roles and responsibilities of the Leadership Council; and demonstrate a desire to be a member of the Leadership Council. Members in good standing between the ages of 21-24 are eligible to be non-voting participants provided they have served the church in some capacity, agree to one year participation, and approval of congregational voters.

Duties: The spiritual leadership and management of the business activities and other affairs of ECBF shall be governed by the Leadership Council (also referred to as Council) or their qualified appointees, who shall be ultimately responsible to the Council. As the church holds the belief that the New Testament places the burden of governing on a plurality of leaders, the Council shall oversee the congregation and make policy decisions with regard to the affairs, function, direction, and business of the church. These decisions must reflect a clear biblical perspective and the best interest of the church. The Chair, or other Council members authorized by the Council, shall have the authority to execute documents, deeds, contracts, and any other legal papers necessary to transact the business of the church. The Council will conduct a performance evaluation with the Pastor annually. The Chair will deliver the results of the evaluation to the Pastor and provide opportunity for inquiries.

Commitment: Involves responsibilities as listed above and:

- Attend monthly Leadership Council meetings, including some extra meeting per year, as needed
- Demonstrate a presence in and commitment to the ECBF body:
- Attend regularly on Sunday mornings, exceptions-out of town or vacation
- Arrive at 10 a.m. Sunday morning
- Participate in ECBF Wednesday night activities (encouraged to attend Monthly prayer meeting)
- Attend quarterly All-Church leadership Meetings
- Involvement in some aspect of ministry
