**ABUNDANT** John 10:10 I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

**CALLED** Psalm 120:1 In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me.”

**CARES** 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

**COMFORT** Psalm 23:4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

**COMPLETE** Philippians 1:6- being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

**COURAGE** Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the Lord your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.

**DENY** Luke 9:23 (NIV) Then he said to them all: “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.

**ENCOURAGE** 1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.

**EQUIP** 2nd Timothy 3:16-17- All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

**ETERNAL** John 17:3 (NIV) Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

**FLOURISH** Proverbs 11:28 (MSG) A life devoted to things is a dead life, a stump; a God-shaped life is a flourishing tree.

**FOLLOW** Matthew 4:19- Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."

**FORGIVE** Ephesians 4:32- And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you.

**GLORIFY** 1 Corinthians 6:20- For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

**GOOD** Romans 8:28- And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

**GRACE** 2 Corinthians 12:9 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

**GROW** 1 Peter 3:18 Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen.

**IMAGINE** Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly and abundantly more than all we can ask or imagine.

**LEARN** Philippians 4:9 Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me - put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

**LIFE** John 14:6- Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

**LIGHT** Matthew 5:16- "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

**LISTEN** James 1:19 My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone would be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

**LIVE** John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies."

**MOTIVATE** Galatians 5:16 (MSG) My counsel is this: Live freely, animated and motivated by God's Spirit. my God will hear me.

**NEW** 2 Corinthians 5:17- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

**OVERCOME** John 16:33 (NIV) "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

**PEACE** Philippians 4:6-7- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

**PERSIST** Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

**PORTION** Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

**POSSIBLE** Mark 10:27 Jesus looked at them and said, 'With man it is impossible, but not with God. For all things are possible with God.'

**POWER** 2 Timothy 1:7 For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.

**POWER** Isaiah 40:29 He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength.

**PRAYER** Colossians 4:2 Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving;

**RADICAL** Mark 6:12 (MSG) They preached with joyful urgency that life can be radically different.

**REJOICE** 1Thessalonians 5:16-18- Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

**REST** Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

**ROCK** Psalm 62:6 He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken.

**SACRIFICE** Romans 12:1 (NIV) Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

**SAFE** Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous man runs into it and is safe.

**SATISFY** Psalm 63:1 You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.

**SEEK** Matthew 6:33 "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

**SERVE** Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**SHINE** Philippians 2:14-15 Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,

**SING** Psalms 96:2 Sing to the LORD, bless His name; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

**STEADFAST** Lamentations 3:22-23 The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

**STRAIGHT** Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths

**STRENGTH** Isaiah 41:10- Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

**STRENGTH** Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

**STRONG** Joshua 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

**SUPPLY** Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

**THRIVE** Proverbs 11:28 Those who trust in their riches will fall, but the righteous will **thrive** like a green leaf.

**TRANSFORM** Romans 12:2 (NIV) Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be **transformed** by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

**TRUST** Proverbs 3:5-6- **Trust** in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

**TRUST** Psalms 56:3- Whenever I am afraid, I will **trust** in You.

**TRUTH** 1 John 3:18 Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in **truth**.

**WAIT** Isaiah 40:31- But those who **wait** on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

**WAIT** Micah 7:7 (MSG) But me, I'm not giving up. I'm sticking around to see what God will do. I'm **waiting** for God to make things right.

**WATCH OR WAIT** Micah 7:7 (NIV) But as for me, I **watch** in hope for the Lord, I **wait** for God my Savior; I'm counting on God to listen to me. I'm sticking around to see what God will do. I'm **waiting** for God to make things right.

**Galatians 5:22-23-** But the fruit of the Spirit is **love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.** Against such there is no law.
