

Things on our agenda will include: touring Choctaw Hall and enjoying wonderful 3 course meal there, visiting Sunnyside, Stanton Hall, lunch at the Carriage House, tour Frogmore Plantation including the Christmas Quarters with stories of the old South-Civil War soldiers, Cotton kingpins, slaves and share-croppers. We will also pay a visit to Concord Quarters for the lighting of the Yule log, then head over to The Jeweled Christmas Tour at the Towers- one of the most unique seasonal tours in the South. No trip would be complete without a little time to explore downtown Natchez Historic District and enjoy some wonderful food together!


