

**"Bible 101:  
The Most Difficult Admission"**  
Romans 7

Christ-followers limit what God will do in us because we're often too proud to make the most difficult admission: a battle rages in us between submitting to God's Spirit or giving in to rebellious tendencies. Paul gives us three certainties proving why "being more religious" isn't enough to win the war.

**Certainty 1:**

(Romans 7:1-6)

**Religious \_\_\_\_\_ are described as a contract,  
and death cancels contracts.**

*Christ died to cancel death's contract on us.*

**Certainty 2:**

(Romans 7:7-13)

**God's laws are good & function like an \_\_\_\_\_  
showing us our tendency to rebel.**

*Christ gave us these laws to help us see how much  
we need His help in obeying them.*

**Certainty 3:**

(Romans 7:14-25)

**Experiencing new life in Christ while being tempted by  
our old ways can feel schizophrenic!  
IT IS NOT! It is a \_\_\_\_\_.**

*Christ's available power daily transfuses us!*
