



## Community Foundation of Pulaski County (CFPC) 2018 GRANTS and GUIDELINES

Beginning in 2018, Community Foundation of Pulaski County will accept grant proposals on a **continuous basis**. There are no specific deadlines for submitting applications. Please keep in mind that it may take approximately six to eight weeks to review proposals and contact you with an initial response.

Please review these Grant Guidelines to ensure your project fits within them. Some grants have specific guidelines, found on the Grants page of the CF website. You are encouraged to contact the CFPC office to discuss your project before beginning. Applications must be submitted online.

### **Types of CFPC Grants:**

- **Youth** – *for youth organizations seeking grants up to \$500 to improve existing programs or create new youth projects in the school or community.*
- **Field of Interest Grants** – *three grants are available for specific charitable purposes: adult education; educationally disadvantaged children/adults; wildlife conservation and education. Grant amounts vary.*
- **Community Grants** – *for organizations seeking grants in the range of several hundred to several thousand dollars. These are designed to be awarded to several organizations, providing support throughout Pulaski County.*
- **Sustainability Grants (NEW)** - *for 501(c)(3) organizations who wish to create their own endowment fund in the Community Foundation. A \$5,000 matching grant can enable an organization to establish a \$10,000 permanent endowment and provide a stable source of income for its mission.*
- **Impact Grants (NEW)** - *for organizations seeking funds to support a large project in the range of \$10,000 - \$20,000. Grantmaking areas of interest as stated in CFPC's vision and commitment statement include Community Development; Education; Environment. A Letter of Intent and project summary is the first required step in seeking an Impact Grant.*

CFPC grants shall serve Pulaski County and its communities. Specific requirements pertaining to each type of grant are included on the individual applications.

Final reports are required of all grantees in order to be considered for future grant funding.
