1. La Ola Orphanage, Mexico

Project Cost: \$1000
TYPE: Ministry Trip

TRIP INFORMATION:

We will be conducting VBS with the children at the orphanage and maybe some village children, too. We will take food to one or two villages. We may have an opportunity to do a service at one of the villages. We should be in the new building by then, so we will probably have some building projects as well.

TRIP INFORMATION:

A discipleship camp where lessons are taught, plus games and other activities each day. Teams also help with light construction/maintenance on campus. For travel, the first night is in a hotel in Dhaka. The rest of the nights are spent in our very nice guest rooms on campus. (AC, hot water, etc.)

Same as last year. Building mud huts, some ministry, with a safari day.

4. Spain (Keith & Christi Jones)

September 3-12, 2026

Individual Cost: \$1,500Project Cost: \$15,000TYPE: Construction Trip

PURPOSE:

The Garden helps missionaries who are struggling, in transition, burnt out, stressed out, not adjusting well, etc. When a missionary is healthy in all areas of their life, they can go the distance. However, the enemy works overtime to trip people up and cause them to give up. Supporting missionaries in times of need gives them an opportunity to gain a different perspective and feel cared for and supported.

TRIP INFORMATION:

Flights are typically \$580-\$730. The per diem cost is \$100 per day. 8 days (\$800 per person plus airfare would run from \$1380 to \$1530 at today's rate). There is a back area on the property already leveled. There's an olive tree with a platform for a treehouse, but no "walls" yet, so we can't let kids use it for safety reasons. We desire a playground for missionary kids so they can play and families can bond through recreation while they are here for their parents' health. Assembling playground equipment will be a big portion of the project. We also desire a 1/2 basketball court that would double as a pickleball court. Additionally, if possible, we'd like to install some outdoor workout equipment (pull-up bars, etc) for adults.

A sample schedule would be work 8:30-5:00 or so daily. It will still be hot, so we encourage people to break as needed. We do have a pool on the property, so after work, some enjoy cooling off there. In September, our days are still long (sun setting around 9:30), so we take a few evenings to do fun things. We realize for some, this will be their one-and-only trip to Spain, so we want them to get to see/experience things, as they have made a sacrifice to make this trip. There is a town ½ hour from us called Mijas. We like to take everyone there for shopping/ice cream one day after work. We will also take the team to the Mediterranean Sea one day after work for a dip. Before church, we go out for Churros/Chocolate and Coffee. Then, after church, we go out to eat in the city of Malaga, walk through the streets, see the old city, the Roman amphitheater, the Alcazaba, an 11th-century Muslim fortress, and then enjoy ice cream and shopping at the Malaga port. It is a full day of walking, but everyone has enjoyed it.

5. Philippines (John & Kelli Williford, Happy Horizons Children's Ranch)

March 8-16, 2027

Individual Cost: \$2,000Project Cost: \$1,000

• TYPE: Ministry Trip (Women, Spouses, & Children)

PURPOSE:

Ministry to girls rescued from sexual exploitation. They are highly sensitive to the presence of men. In the Philippines, 90% of foreign men traveling alone are there to find a girlfriend. At HHCR, we allow men to come IF they are traveling with their wife or daughter. For our girls and team, this allows them to know this is a safe male.

TRIP INFORMATION:

This is during the school year. So, unless the team can help in school, we would find something for them to do during the day, and the team would begin their ministry focus with our kids starting at 3pm. We usually recommend \$500 per team as a starter for "project or ministry" funds. These would be funds the teams use for the ministry focus. Some is spent in the USA to bring items, and some is sent in advance so items can be purchased.

Trip cost is \$1,200 or more, which is the average ticket cost. \$45 a night, plus ministry funds, plus a funday. That cost will include 3 meals a day while on campus. The average trip on the ground is 7 days. An example would be landing on Wednesday and departing the following Tuesday or Wednesday. As a note, traveling to the Philippines is a long process. Our recent trip was 30 hours of travel time – flights plus layovers

The team will be doing kids and youth ministry. We will also go into the community to share the gospel in homes. There could be youth service on Friday night, kids service on Saturday morning, and adult service on Sunday. We like to adjust each trip based on the team's skills. If you have teachers, they can help at our school. If you have cooks, they can help in our kitchen. If you have people with art skills, music, or tech, we will make space for them to "skill share" with the kids. We prefer teams to stay on our campus. We have a guest house that can sleep 12 (tightly) or 8 more comfortably.
