by intentionally spreading the Good News everywhere we can.

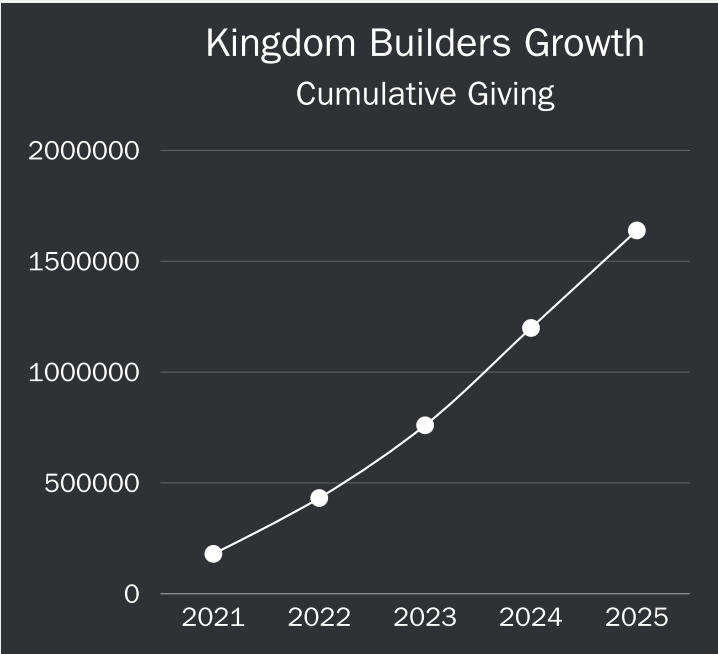
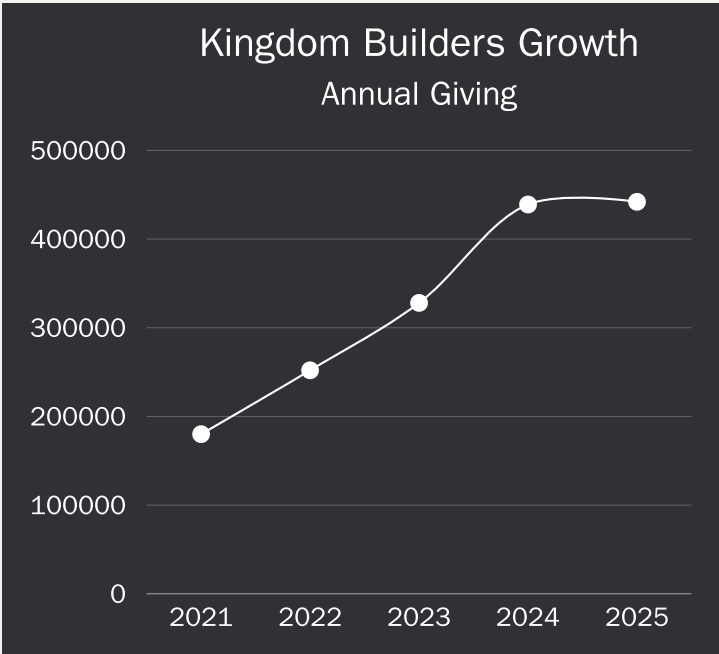

It's someone who realizes they've been bought with a price and because their life is not their own, they're ready to give their lives for an eternal cause far more important than they can fully understand.

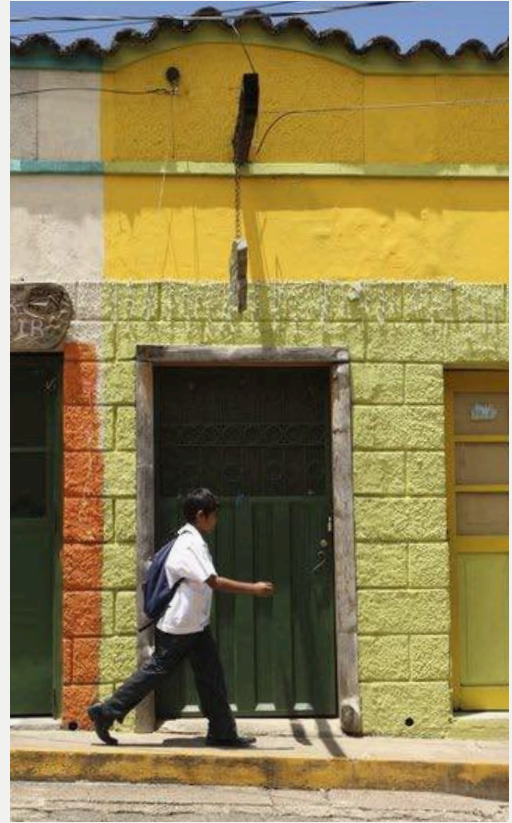
Jesus said, "Wake up and look around.

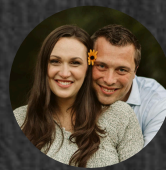

Camp Jackson

📍 Goodlettsville, TN

For over 50 years, the Jackson Conference Center has been sacred ground—where students encounter Jesus, leaders hear God's call, and lives are transformed. Today, after years of deferred maintenance, the center stands at a turning point, yet its impact continues each summer, proving the soil is fertile. A 10–15 year master plan will bring a new worship center, renovated cabins, discipleship spaces, and recreational facilities for this generation and the next. Together, we can steward this place to train leaders, send missionaries, and transform lives for years to come. This is more than construction—it's kingdom investment and a lasting legacy.

Priority One Schools

📍 Uruguay

Hope for Uruguay 100 is a bold initiative to plant 100 churches and build 100 sanctuaries, bringing the hope of Jesus to the nation's least reached areas. At the heart of this vision are the Priority One Bible schools, equipping and mentoring the pastors, evangelists, and missionaries who will lead these churches. The Uruguay campus, a blessing for over 35 years, now needs updates—refreshed dorms, upgraded bathrooms, family-friendly layouts, a secure entrance, a leveled parking lot, and pastoral houses—to empower the next generation of leaders to transform lives and communities for Christ.



World Serve

📍 Senegal

Senegal, a nation of over 18 million people, faces a severe water crisis, with more than 73% lacking access to clean drinking water—impacting health, education, and daily life. While about 95% of the population is Muslim and only 3% identify as Christian, this presents a powerful opportunity to share the Gospel and bring lasting spiritual change. By partnering with the Assemblies of God and WorldServe International to provide sustainable clean water and plant churches, we can help meet both physical and spiritual needs in Senegal.

The team will lead kids and youth ministry, community outreach, and local services, using skills like teaching, cooking, art, music, or tech to make a lasting impact.

One of the most rewarding parts of going on trips is the relationships. We have a wonderful church family, but we often only see them for a short time, and we don’t always get to truly know them. Traveling and serving alongside people allows you to build deep, lasting connections. You really get to know them, and you can truly call them family. That closeness is one of the biggest blessings of these trips.”

"I'm a Kingdom Builder, and that goes back to my early teen years when I felt God put a call on my heart to missions and supporting missionaries. From there, I began praying for missionaries, giving to them financially, and going on mission trips—a practice I've continued my entire life. 1 John 4:19 says, "We love Christ because He first loved us." I think the foundation of me as a Kingdom Builder is giving back to God because He's done so much for me, and I want to see Him do the same for others.

Seeing what God is doing around the world has been inspiring—He's at work here and across the globe, no matter the living conditions, politics, or security. Regularly going on mission trips keeps me grounded and reminds me of what's truly important. Mark 16:15 says, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel." If you haven't gone on a trip, you need to do it. It's life changing and gives you a bigger picture of God's work. And if you haven't thought about giving, I challenge you to pray—God has blessed us abundantly, and we can give a little to reach others for Christ."

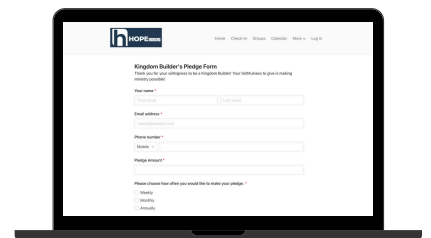
