PSALMS

Psalm 34:8 (NLT) *Taste and see that the LORD is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him!*

Psalm 100:5 (NLT) *For the LORD is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation.*

Psalm 136:1 (NLT) *Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever.*

Psalm 145:9 (NLT) *The LORD is good to everyone. He showers compassion on all his creation.*

Psalm 25:8 (NLT) *The LORD is good and does what is right; he shows the proper path to those who go astray.*

HISTORY BOOKS

1 Chronicles 16:34 (NLT) *Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever.*

2 Chronicles 5:13 (NLT) *"The trumpeters and singers performed together in unison to praise and give thanks to the LORD. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals, and other instruments, they raised their voices and praised the LORD with these words: 'He is good! His faithful love endures forever!' At that moment a thick cloud filled the Temple of the LORD."*

2 Chronicles 7:3 (NLT) *"When all the people of Israel saw the fire coming down and the glorious presence of the LORD filling the Temple, they fell face down on the ground and worshiped and praised the LORD, saying, 'He is good! His faithful love endures forever!'"*

PROPHETIC BOOKS

Nahum 1:7 (NLT) *The LORD is good, a strong refuge when trouble comes. He is close to those who trust in him.*

Jeremiah 33:11 (NLT) *They will sing, 'Give thanks to the LORD of Heaven's Armies, for the LORD is good. His faithful love endures forever!'*

KING DAVID

1 Samuel 19:1 (NLT) *Saul now urged his servants and his son Jonathan to assassinate David.*

1 Samuel 20:1 (NLT) *David now fled from Naioth in Ramah and found Jonathan. "What have I done?" he exclaimed. "What is my crime? How have I offended your father that he is so determined to kill me?"*

Psalm 27:12 (NLT) *Do not let me fall into their hands. For they accuse me of things I've never done; with every breath they threaten me with violence.*

Psalm 13:1-4 (NLT) *1 O LORD, how long will you forget me? Forever? How long will you look the other way? 2 How long must I struggle with anguish in my soul, with sorrow in my heart every day? How long will my enemy have the upper hand? 3 Turn and answer me, O LORD my God! Restore the sparkle to my eyes, or I will die. 4 Don't let my enemies gloat, saying, "We have defeated him!" Don't let them rejoice at my downfall.*

2 Timothy 2:13 (NLT) *"He cannot deny who he is."*

If God can't DENY who He is, it means we will see the EVIDENCE of His goodness in our lives.

Psalm 13:5-6 (NLT) *5 But I trust in your unfailing love. I will rejoice because you have rescued me. 6 I will sing to the LORD because he is good to me.*

Psalm 27:13-14 (NLT) *13 Yet I am confident I will see the LORD's goodness while I am here in the land of the living. 14 Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.*
