THE SONG OF MOSES: Deuteronomy 32:3-4 (NLT)

Justice that involves SPIRITUAL judgment must always be left to God.

Romans 12:19 (NLT) *Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," says the LORD.*

Romans 2:4 (NLT) *"Don't you see how wonderfully kind, tolerant, and patient God is with you? Does this mean nothing to you? Can't you see that his kindness is intended to turn you from your sin?"*

Genesis 18:1 (NLT) *The LORD appeared again to Abraham near the oak grove belonging to Mamre.*
