A HOLY DISCONTENT

It's been an amazing year. Our wonderful God has been so good and so faithful, as He always has been and always will be. I'm grateful for His blessings in my life. The longer I live, the more I realize that, thanks to His mercy, I don't get what I deserve, and because of His grace, I receive everything I can't earn.

I'm also finding myself increasingly focused on two overwhelming yet contradictory desires. In Philippians 1:21-22 (NLT), Paul writes, "For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better. 22 But if I live, I can do more fruitful work for Christ. So, I really don't know which is better."

I'm looking forward to heaven, but I also know there is so much work for God's Kingdom yet to be accomplished. There are so many people who need to hear the Good News of Jesus. So, if I'm going to hang around this planet a little longer, I don't want to keep experiencing church the way it is now. I love our church. I love THE church, but I'm developing a holy discontent for life as it has been.

When Jesus walked this earth, He said, in John 14:12-14 (NLT), "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. 13 You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. 14 Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!"

Jesus said, I believe it, and I'm anyone, so where is it? Throughout my life, I've seen flashes of His glory. There have been moments when I know I'm standing on holy ground. But, more often than not, I feel like the Old Testament prophet Habakkuk.

King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon had conquered the nation of Israel in 597 B.C. Thousands had been carried off into captivity, so God raised up a prophet who began to intercede for his people. He began to pray that God would miraculously intervene in their situation. Here's what he said in Habakkuk 3:2 (NIV): "LORD, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, LORD. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known..."

Habakkuk was desperately praying for revival! There was a holy discontentment – a holy desperation – rising in His spirit that couldn't be contained. He'd only heard about God's miracles. He'd never experienced them firsthand. He was no longer content with hearing about what God had done in the past. He was desperate for God to move in HIS day.

Habakkuk knew that there is a price to be paid for revival. There's a cost to acting on our holy discontent. Things can't stay as they have been to fully embrace where the Spirit is leading us. There are some things we can't do, and some things we must do to create space for the miraculous – to see the deeds of the Lord in our day.

In the 13th century B.C., there was a King named Hezekiah. Scripture says this about him in 2 Chronicles 31:21 (NLT): "In all that he did in the service of the Temple of God and in his efforts to follow God's laws and commands, Hezekiah sought his God wholeheartedly. As a result, he was very successful."

And there we see the key to responding to a holy discontent. It's seeking God with no reservations. Hezekiah sought his God – he established a relationship with the Almighty God for himself – with his WHOLE heart.

As we enter this new year, I want my holy discontent to increase. I want my satisfaction with the distractions of this world to fade and my longing for Jesus to grow. I want it to burn more brightly in my heart than it ever has before.

All God needs for revival is a remnant...a handful of people who will say, "Yes, Lord!"

In 2026, will we say, "Yes?" Will we choose to be part of the remnant? Will we choose to embrace a holy discontent?




