### **School Report (Led by T Zavos)**

Tom Zavos spoke about special guests of the school board who are with us today to speak regarding expanding the schools.

Joe Kyzick daughter Julia is in the Pre K program and she has concerns that the public schools and how they are pushing dangerous ideologies to children. They are pleased with the program and would like and strongly urge to consider expanding the schools

Louie Pyschogios spoke and knows there are hurdles in starting the schools - but encourages the PC to take a steps forward as they are not looking for something spectacular but to merely expand the dayschool.

Despina Calebrese has 2 children in the day school program. She understands that there is obstacles. She talked about VCS and how it has transformed into church camp. It can be done.

Parents commented that it would not matter if it would be accredited or not.

Tom Kanelos addressed that we do not fear with going forward and we do need a plan. Run into an imposition from the metropolis since the high school is being built.

Parent said that they have reached out to other churches and they are willing to share their curriculum with us.

The parents are asking for our blessings to do the right thing.

Despina believes that 7 families for this coming year would be interested in a first grade classroom.

Father Dean stated that it will take active participation from the parents to make this happen not just from the school board and PC.
