

2021 Camp Scholarship Program- Spring

Dear Camper Families:

Because Covid-19 is still an issue, the spring portion of the scholarship program will look just the same as the fall portion. This program allows our kids to earn their scholarship for camp in ways in which they are familiar. However, there are not many opportunities for serving in the church or in church events, so some things are different. I am always available for your questions, by phone, text or email.

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Registration:

Hopefully, you have already registered.

If not, go to lakeanncamp.com to register.

Use the discount code **BIBLETC**. This will keep your total at \$125 per camper, and notifies the camp that your child will be participating in our scholarship program. If your camper drops out of the program, I will notify the camp and your total due will be adjusted.

If you have 3 or more campers in your family, your multi-child discount should be applied to your registration fee. For example, three campers at \$125 each, should be a total of \$375. Minus the \$75 third child discount. Your new total should be \$300. Please, call me if this isn't how it works out.

Weeks typically fill up quickly. If you are unsure, make your best guess. You may change weeks later if needed, as long as there is room in the week you want.

2021 Camp Scholarship Program

Campers will be allowed to earn points towards their scholarship by:

Devos & Prayer: (All Campers)

Age appropriate, daily quiet time. Should include the reading of scripture and prayer. Junior campers can count family devotions. However, older campers should have their own time. Pastor Dan is a great resource for age-appropriate devotional material. 5 points per week.

Scripture Memory: (All Campers)

Campers in AWANA may count sections they say beginning in September. 5 points per section.

If your camper does not participate in AWANA, they may memorize verses from Psalm 91 or Psalm 46. Parents may hear verses. 5 points per verse.

Church ministry: (Junior High, Fresh Start, Senior High)

This can be any weekly/monthly church ministry.

For example: Assisting in Sonshine Kids or Kidztown, Praise Team

Maximum: 2 ministries per month (10 pts per/20 pts total)

Please make plans with program leaders.

Outreach Ministry: (All Campers)

Outreach can be any kind of serving outside of the church. Helping a neighbor with any work, volunteering at any para church organization (like a food pantry or Reining Liberty Ranch), making a meal for and visiting a shut in, etc. Any kind of service without payment can be counted. Please record approximate time spent. Points will be given based on time, approximately 10 points per hour, with a 10 point minimum. Maximum of 30 pts/month for Juniors & Jump Start Campers, 40 pts/month for Junior High, Fresh Start & Senior High.

If, perchance, we are able to have a church event (like Parent Date

Night) before the end of the year, you may record your ministry in that capacity under the Outreach Ministry section of your card.

Encouragement Opportunities: (All Campers)

This could be sending a note in the mail to anyone your camper thinks might need encouraging. It could be dropping off a gift or treat. Anything your campers does just to be an encouragement to someone they know, even friends or classmates. 10 points. One per month.

Sharing your faith: (all campers):

Right now is a great time to be bold in sharing our faith. If your camper is able to share the Gospel, they can fill out the report form and turn it in for credit. 20 pts. (Forms are outside Pastor Dan's office.)

Filling out the record:

Check mark the spaces as your camper completes devotions. I know there are only 5 spaces per week. Call it grace.

Note what verses have been memorized.

Please make a note of what ministries your child has been involved in the proper spaces.

Fall Forms (Sept.—Dec.) must be turned in by January 10th.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

You may turn them in as they are finished (I will keep track of them). Or you may submit them all in January (you keep track of them).

Goals:

Your camper's goal is the cost of their camp week minus the \$125 you will pay. Their cost is dependent on when you register.

Register by September 6th, save \$30

Register by December 31st, save \$20

Register by March 15th, save \$10

(Unused funds earned last year may also be applied.)

First Year Campers:

First time campers get 50 points to get them started.
