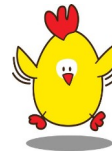
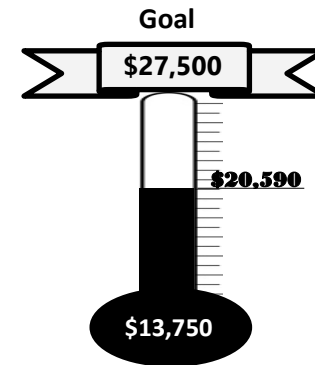
Lesson 38: God protects Paul.
