4 Reminders About the Lord's Supper



Author: John the beloved Apostle (written 90 AD)

Audience: Written to both Jews and Gentiles

Setting: In verses, Jesus and Disciples in Jerusalem to celebrate Passover (this last week of Jesus' earthly ministry before His crucifixion)

Here, see Upper Room teaching by Jesus shortly before His arrest

REMINDER OF THE ETERNAL LOVE JESUS HAS FOR US.

(v. 1) On eve before His crucifixion, Jesus gathered with Disciples; only has a short time left to impart Kingdom truth

In last hours, Jesus not concerned with Himself or His needs, He concerned about Disciples well-being

Repeated His great love for Disciples and then proved that love by washing their feet; loved them “completely”

REMINDER THAT WE HAVE AN ENEMY WHO
SEEKS TO DESTROY US.

(v. 2) As Jesus working in love, there another force
at work; extreme evil (Satan)

Satan had entered Judas and used him to betray
Jesus

We have an enemy who works to tear down and
disrupt; he wants to destroy God's work and
believers' lives



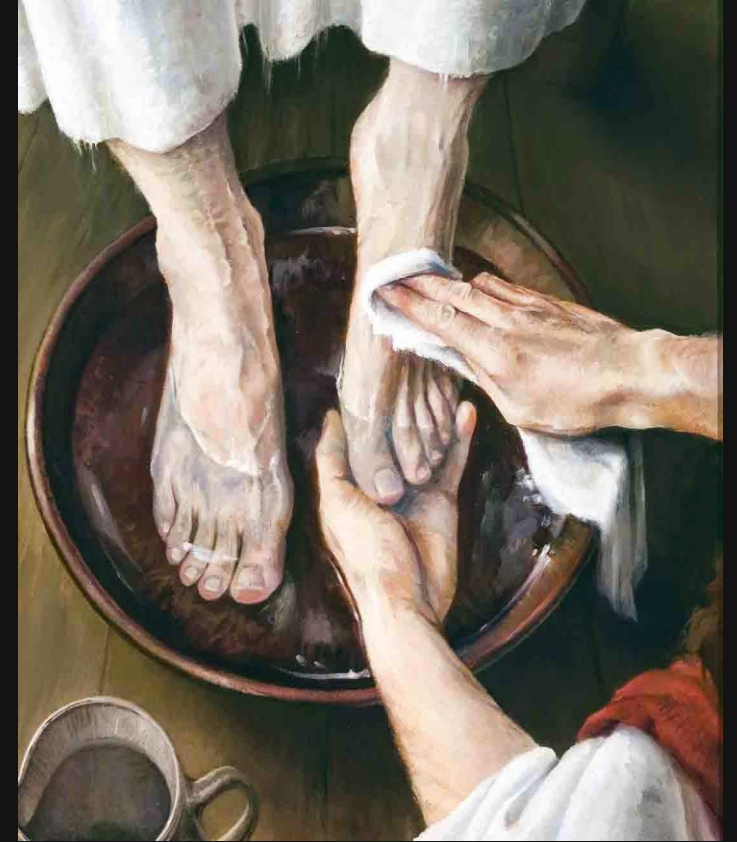

REMINDER OF THE RESPONSIBILITY OF SACRIFICIAL SERVICE.

(vv. 3-16) The foundation of Jesus' life and ministry was service!

Even though Cross near, Jesus did work of lowly slave so as to share example for Disciples

Jesus set the example for all believers; we are to meet needs, heal hurts, share Gospel

REMINDER OF THE SOVEREIGNTY OF JESUS.

(vv. 18-19) Jesus affirmed everything that happening was according to the Scriptures
