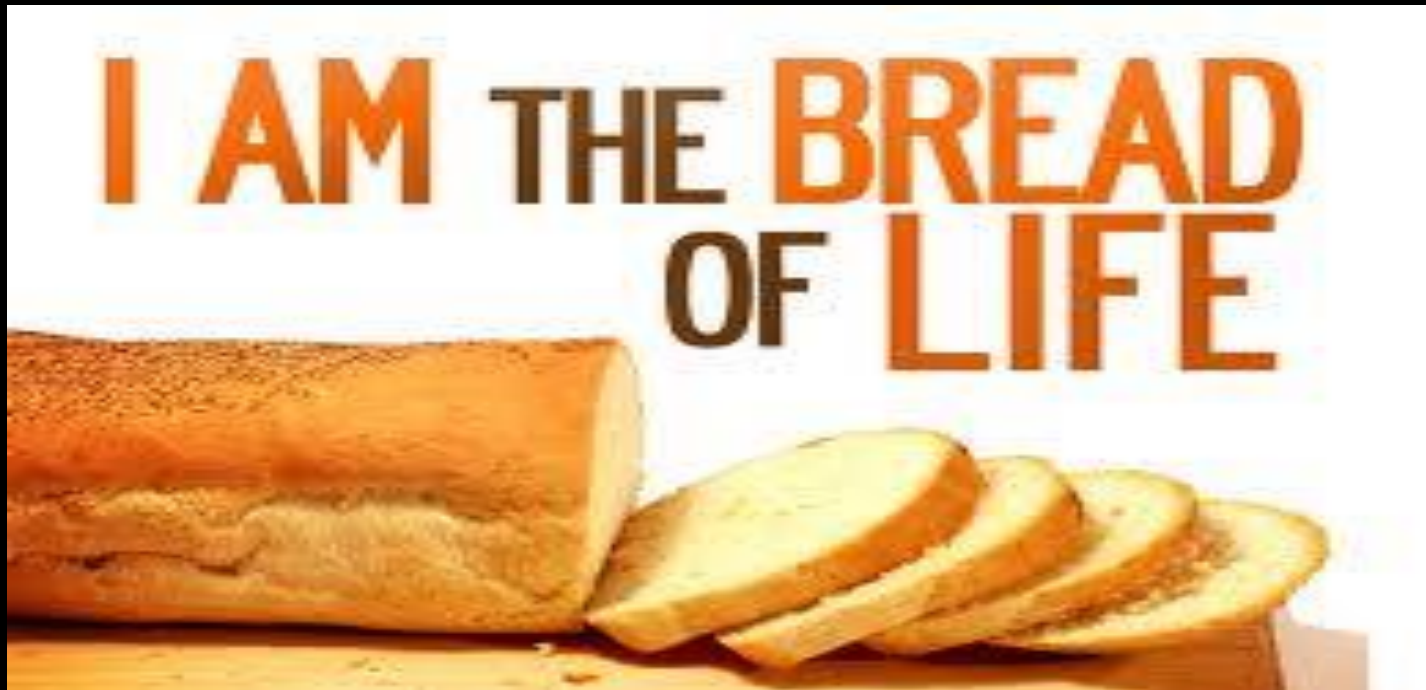
Three Remembrances Of The Lord's Supper



Recalling The Serving Ministry Of Jesus Christ

- (v.22) That special night, Jesus took bread, identified Himself with it
- Bread: symbol of life, nourishment, strength
- Jesus sharing; He is our supply and strength; He has come to help us, forgive us, save us
- Jesus came as lowly slave; though He was and is due all worship, He humbled Himself and served
- The wafer; reminder of life and ministry of Jesus

- John 6:48, (Jesus said) “I am the bread of life.”

Realizing The Sacrificing Ministry Of Jesus Christ

- (vv.23-25) Jesus went on, put very special emphasis on cup
- Jesus said this cup was symbol of His blood; shed for all people; now New Covenant
- New Covenant; no longer need Temple or animal sacrifice; complete forgiveness through the one time sacrifice of Jesus on Cross
- Now all can be forgiven, accepted, and made new

- 2 Corinthians 5:17, “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”



Supporting Ministry Between Believers

- (v.26) Mark records (after Judas left) disciples were all in one accord; there unity
- They worshiped and celebrated Passover; sang songs and fellowshiped
- Communion; time to remember we are different but brothers and sisters in Christ
- There are hurting people all around us
- Before meal; take spiritual inventory
