Jeremiah 31:31a, 33b

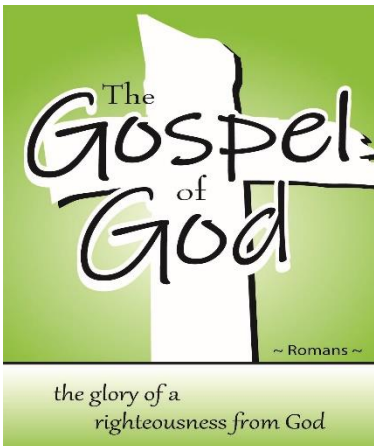
WORSHIP PREPARATION

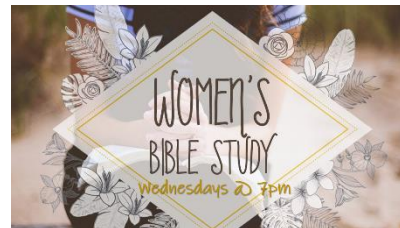
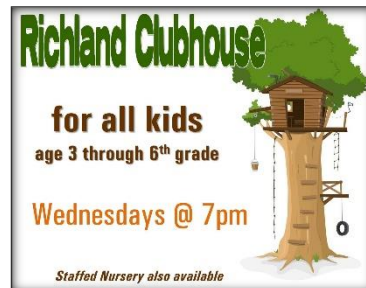
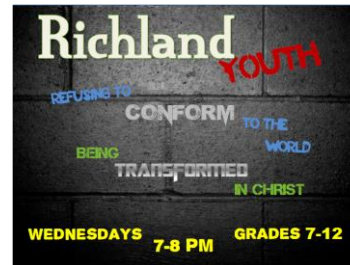
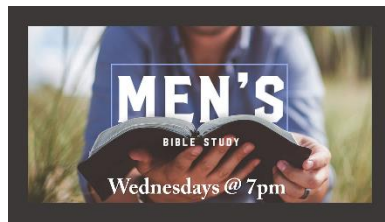
Valentine Care Package Addresses
