

Schedule details for the upcoming retreat:

Friday, 6:15pm - Drop-off at GCC (eat dinner before arriving)

Below are the rules I expect students to follow. Please review them (especially if this is your first retreat with GCC) and parents please come inside at drop off on Friday so we can review the rules all together as a group before leaving. We will do this in the middle school room. So, when you come on Friday, put your luggage in the high school room and then gather in the middle school room. If you haven't filled out a GCC Permission slip yet for the year you will need to fill one out before we take off.

GCC Retreat Rules:

1. No personal, electronic, entertainment devices are permitted. They work contrary to our purpose for this event and will be confiscated by the leadership for the weekend.
2. Appropriate and modest clothing should be worn at all times. The focus should be on God not each other's bodies.
3. No Public Displays of Affection. (PDA) Students are not permitted to "couple" off on their own at any time for any reason. Inappropriate touching is unacceptable at any time.
4. No illegal substances or beverages are permitted to be bought or brought on this trip – no exceptions.
5. All meals and meetings are mandatory and ...this means being on time with your materials and hearts ready.
6. Cruel practical jokes and "Hazing" go directly against our purpose for the weekend and will not be tolerated.
7. Disobedience, Talking Back, or simply disrespecting adult leaders or other authorities on this trip will not be tolerated.
8. All food is to be put away at night or kept in the kitchen with the exception of water. We must avoid spills & stains.
9. Foul language, crude humor and tearing people down verbally are unacceptable and won't be tolerated.
10. Adherence to any other rules that leaders feel are necessary for your safety or the purpose of the event on this retreat.
