Pastor Peter will be participating in a Kairos weekend, September 11 – 13, at Lee State Prison. Kairos Prison Ministry International is

a Christian ministry that brings the love and forgiveness of Jesus Christ to incarcerated individuals and their families. It's a lay-led, interdenominational ministry with three main programs: Kairos Inside, Kairos Outside, and Kairos Torch. Kairos Inside is a ministry whose mission is to develop a Christian community inside prisons, bringing positive and negative leaders together, in both male and female institutions, for a 3 ½ day Weekend led by same gender Kairos volunteers.

The Weekend is based on: A series of talks, Discussions, Chapel meditations, and Creating a Christian community.

For many participants, the Kairos Weekend creates the desire to become a Christian, and for others the desire to continue his/her spiritual growth.

How can you help? PRAY during this weekend that hearts will be opened, lives will be changed, and for the presence of God's grace and love to fill the room.
