Worthy of Worship

Worthy of Worship will more than likely go down as one of my all-time favorite worship songs. According to our hymnal, the text is attributed to Terry W. York, and the music was composed by Mark Blankenship. The tune was named JUDSON and the hymn was published in 1988. I remember singing this hymn as a child at FBC Wilson many times. My first job out of college was a Worship Leader position at a small Baptist church in Durham, NC called Durham Memorial Baptist Church. I recall using this hymn on several occasions during our worship services there, and I have continued to use it in worship here at NBC. If you keep track, you probably notice that I use this hymn in worship at least once, maybe twice a quarter. There is just something about it that truly draws me into a worshipful mindset and typically when we sing it, every person in the congregation is singing along! I particularly enjoy the final stanza which lists several different names for God and Jesus. Almighty Father, Master, Lord, King of all kings, Redeemer, Wonderful Counselor, Comforter, Friend, Saviour, and last but not least, the source of our life without end. There is something about proclaiming those words together as the music builds toward its climactic moment when we all sing, "You are worthy!" at the top of our lungs. I challenge you to take note of this stanza the next time we use this hymn in worship. I have included the text of the hymn below for you to read. I pray that this text will bring you comfort as you read it and that it will remind you of our God and that he is indeed worthy of our worship.
