A Note from the Pastor



Have you heard of the newest design trend capturing everyone’s attention in 2024? This “new” trend is called **Bookshelf Wealth!** This concept in design thought grabbed the limelight following a video by an interior designer on the TikTok platform. The designer describes how to bring this to your space and provides photo examples. One description explains, “The idea is to create a carefully curated collection of well-loved books and treasured mementos gathered overtime. This new design trend is perfect for those who love an eclectic look. So, think of books, artwork, ceramics, photos and trinkets. And a plant or two won’t look out of place.”

In truth, this design concept has returned as a point of emphasis. It is not new, and once I read more about it, I realized bookshelf wealth might surround me. The many shelves in my church study and conference room are filled with books and items gathered throughout years of pastoring across our fair state. Yet, as I delved further into this trend, I found another description more in line with my surroundings: **Bibliophile Aesthetic.**
