Luke 6:46 (ESV)*


The last line in the chorus of a 1975 song released by the Catalinas states, “But it’s different now that summertime’s callin’ me.” The month of June is when the voice of Summer begins to lure us as a siren song—calling us away from everyday experiences to the activities often excluded from other seasons of the year. I fall prey to this compelling voice each year and long to answer the call.

Summer is the season of vacations, and each society has its own cultural norms. In much of Europe (especially Italy and France), cities partially shut down when local urbanites take their “Beach Breaks.” Imagine driving into Raleigh to find that you cannot see a dentist, work stops on a home being built, or the grocery store being closed. Our American work ethic would not respond positively to this concept.

Yet, Summer is still a time when “things” slow down and a large portion of society takes time away. Hear me; I love my time away. My family took vacations each year, often in the Fall, because Summer was the time for the tobacco harvest. I still value these opportunities to take time and visit places not usually on my travel itinerary. It just makes sense to do this during the Summer slowdown.

The Body of Christ is not immune to the Summer exodus. The call of summertime does not have to call in a clear voice for us to be ready to answer. Why does it take very little to pull us away from the faith community, and something monumental must occur to draw us from personal pursuits? I always expect the Summer slump, but the Church faces more than this in our modern world.

Is it different now that summertime is calling? Summer of 2023 is a time I hope to get away for a bit, but I also have set a goal to fulfill. Amid this, there is another commitment often forgotten. Hearing the voice of Christ calling His disciples never takes a break, even when summertime is calling. The basic question is, “Will I obey Christ’s teachings?” At all times, in all places, and without hesitation.
