## From Our Pastor



### Staying awake

Like many of you, my thoughts turn to the approaching snowstorm. When there is even a small chance of snow on a Sunday, I find myself checking the weather more often than usual. Sunday mornings place me “on call,” and the first thing I do is confirm whether the church parking lot has been plowed. I am grateful to our Trustees for their careful supervision in making sure it is safe. I take this responsibility seriously, because the well-being of those who come to worship matters.

As the reports about the storm continue, my focus begins to shift. I move from simply watching the forecast to preparing for what might happen. I look in the refrigerator and think about meals. I charge phones and laptops and gather portable batteries in case the power goes out. I take out extra blankets and think about firewood. Preparation, in these moments, becomes an act of care.

That shift in thinking leads me to another question. Do we prepare with the same care for spiritual storms? We know how to stock up on food, batteries, and blankets. But when a season of uncertainty, grief, exhaustion, or deep questioning starts to take shape, do we recognize it in time? Do we build reserves of prayer, community, patience, and trust before the storm arrives, or only after we find ourselves in the dark?

Weather forecasts are never perfect, yet they are offered thoughtfully, based on careful study, to help people prepare. In a similar way, our spiritual lives are shaped less by certainty and more by attentiveness. Wisdom grows when we learn to notice the signs, tend what sustains us, and prepare our hearts ahead of time—so that when the storm does come, we are not simply trying to get through it, but are steady enough to endure and able to care for one another along the way.
