

From Our Pastor

Dear Beloved Community of Cheshire,



I still remember the first time I played musical chairs. I was so captivated by the music that I forgot the main goal—finding a seat before the music stopped. As the game went on, chairs were removed one by one, and the pressure to find a place grew. At our recent Church Council meeting, I introduced three empty chairs to help us think more deeply about how we make decisions

as a church. One chair stood for someone outside our congregation. Another represented someone within Cheshire UMC whose voice may not yet have been heard. And the third was what I called the "Jesus chair"—a sacred reminder to ask: If Jesus were seated among us, what would He say? What truth would He speak? What grace would He offer?

These weren't just empty seats. They were visual cues—meant to slow us down, open our hearts, and help us listen more carefully to those who are often overlooked. They call us to imagine: Who is missing from the conversation? Whose voice do we need to hear? And what might Jesus be thinking in this very moment?

Now, maybe I've done to you what the music once did to me—I've drawn your attention to something so vivid that you've forgotten we're not playing musical chairs at all. But if it made you pause and think—about others, about Jesus—then maybe that's exactly the point.
