#### From Our Pastor



At a recent Connecticut District clergy gathering, we were asked a simple but profound question: *Why do you do ministry where you are?* 

It made me think of the disciples. They walked closely with Jesus—saw him, heard him, ate with him—and still they wrestled with doubt, fear, and even frustration. Later, when they became apostles—literally "those who are sent"—their calling was not just to follow Jesus but to go where God's heart ached.

So why do we do what we do? This isn't just a question about survival or existence; it's about purpose. And purpose is never static. It involves both a journey and a destination, a process and a product. Which leads to more questions: What is our purpose? Where are we headed? Who is traveling with us? And to whom are we sent?

I admit, I carry more questions than answers. But maybe that's the point. Instead of trying to settle it with an easy response, I want to leave us with a different direction to ponder:

What would our community miss if the church was not here?

That question, too, begins with why.
