

**Suggested Questions for Doxa Church G2 Groups**  
**1 Corinthians 10:1-13, “Learning from History,” May 17, 2026, Kevin Stuhlmann**

**\*Main Point: *Israel’s disobedience and God’s judgment warn us against spiritual arrogance and carelessness toward sin.***

1. Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-13. In verses 1-5, what spiritual blessings does Paul say Israel experienced during the exodus and wilderness time? From your biblical knowledge, what other blessings did the people of Israel (and Judah) experience throughout their Old Testament history?

2. What are some of the blessings that we experience individually and corporately by being part of the church community? Why don’t these blessings guarantee spiritual obedience or even salvation?

3. In verses 6-11, Paul lays out the reasons that “with most of them God was not pleased” (v. 5). For each of the four examples given, what factors can lead to that sin? And what do these sins look like today?
