

Suggested Questions for Doxa Church G2 Groups
1 Corinthians 15:1-11, “Of First Importance,” August 30, 2026, Kevin Stuhlmann

***Main Point:** *The gospel is of first importance, and Christ's resurrection is essential to it.*

1. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. Paul begins by “reminding” his readers of the gospel. As Christians, why is it sometimes easy to “forget” the gospel, or at least to think, feel, and live like we have forgotten it? What happens when we do?
2. For each of the five verbs in verses 1-2a (which Kevin called “steps in the gospel process”): What does each one look like? Why is each one necessary?
3. How do you respond to this reminder about the gospel and your own life?
4. In verses 3-8, Paul focuses on the death and resurrection of Christ as “the heart” of the gospel. Why is this the case? What other gospel truths do we need to communicate in our evangelism?

5. What is the significance of “in accordance with the Scriptures” (vv. 3, 4)? What is the significance of “he appeared” (vv. 5, 6, 7, 8)? How does this help us personally? How does this help us in witness?
6. How does Paul describe himself in verses 8-10? What does this description show?
7. What practical steps can we take to keep or return the gospel to the place “of first importance” in our lives, with each other, and in our church?
8. What other comments, questions, or personal applications do you have from this passage?
