Bible Study: Exodus 33-34

Exodus 33:12-23

1. [Table] What all does Moses say to and ask of God?
2. What does this reveal about Moses as a person, his mindset, his desires, etc.?
3. What all does God say to Moses in response?
4. What does all this tell us about God?
5. [Large group] As we embark on a study called *Behold Your God*, what lessons can we take from this encounter between God and Moses?

6. [Table] What did God tell Moses to do in order to meet with him? Why?

- 7. What do we learn about preparing to meet with God?**
- 8. Why does God remind Moses that he broke the tablets (v. 1)?**
- 9. What does it mean for God to “proclaim his name (v. 5)?**
- 10. [Large group] How does God describe himself? How would you define or describe each of these characteristics? Look also at verse 14.**
- 11. Obviously, these are integral aspects of God’s nature. But there are others, too. Why does he choose to reveal these characteristics, at this time?**
- 12. What can we learn from Moses’ example about how to respond to God’s revelation of himself to us?**
